Covid Guidelines for On-Campus Rejoining – Grades III & IV
Version 1

Insha'allah, **both Streams of Grades III & IV** will be rejoining on-campus from **Monday 01 February** for term assessments. The schedule has been posted on Grade Assembly of respective grades.

Please read and follow the given guidelines and instructions carefully. Please also note that we as a team will be continuously evaluating the processes and outcomes in the best interest of the school community and revising the guidelines accordingly from time to time, or as per instructions from the Government authorities. Students and parents, please, **be proactive and take charge!**

Symptom Screening

- Students **must not attend** school if...
 - they display any of the symptoms of Covid-19, including fever (more than 100 degrees Fahrenheit), cough, sneezing and shortness of breath (for students with chronic allergic / asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline);
 - they have recently interacted with an individual who is Covid-19 positive; or
 - they have returned from international travel within the past two weeks.
- School staff will check each student's temperature upon arrival at the campus. Any student displaying the above-mentioned symptoms may be asked to **return home**.
 - It is the **parents' responsibility** to not send their children to school if they have any of the above symptoms. Please do be vigilant and alert.
- Any student who develops Covid-19 related symptoms during the school day will be sent to designated areas. If needed, parents will be called for prompt pickup.

What to Bring to School

- **Face Masks** - "*No Mask, No Entry.*"
 - All students are to wear **labelled face masks at all times**, during travel and schooling. Surgical masks are preferable. Cloth masks are also acceptable. Please ensure that your child knows how to wear and handle the mask properly. YouTube videos are available.
- **Hygiene Pack:** Each student to carry...
 - **two additional face masks**, labelled and securely kept in a pack inside the school bag;
 - personal hand sanitizer in their pocket or school bag (as an added measure, hand sanitiser will be made available to students in classrooms during the day, insha'allah); and
 - pocket-sized pack of tissue paper.
- **Snacks and water**
 - Student Canteen will not be operational. Therefore, parents are to please ensure that their child arrives well fed in the morning and is carrying adequate homemade snacks.

- Water coolers will not be operational. Students must carry drinking water in flasks or suitable water bottles for the day.

Maintain Good Hygiene

- Students must adhere to good hygiene practices at all times - in school and at home. Please educate your children. YouTube videos are useful.
 - wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds;
 - use hand sanitizer wherever appropriate;
 - avoid touching their face (eyes, nose, mouth) or face mask; girls' hair must be tied back neatly to minimise the need for touching the face.
 - keep their mouth and nose covered with a mask at all times;
 - avoid touching common surfaces such as rails, doorknobs, grills or window panes; and
 - refrain from sharing belongings with peers including stationery items, books, water bottles, lunch, etc.

School Timings and Drop / Pick

- School timings will continue to be regular (on-campus) timings unless informed otherwise. Please ensure students enter the Campus by **7:35 am** (gates close 7:40 am), and are picked up promptly.
- Due to distancing measures as well as to protect the health and safety of all, parents will not be able to go into student areas. **Front Office dealing will also be limited.** Therefore, for any parents wishing to contact the School, you are advised to please do so via email, WhatsApp or phone - or **request an appointment for a Campus visit.**

Please ensure prompt pick up at home time. Al Makkah Transport service will ply accordingly.

- **All parents, guardians and drivers are to please ensure they are wearing masks** when coming to school for pick up in line with the School's *'No Mask, No Entry'* policy. Please also bear in mind that due to distancing and other measures, the pickup procedures may take longer than usual. Your cooperation and patience in this regard will be critical for the safety of students and others.
- Al Makkah van drivers have been instructed to ensure that they - as well as their passengers - are wearing masks. Van drivers have also been advised to operate the same vehicles with roughly half the number of students. Do emphasize the same to the Al Makkah staff at your end too. Please discuss with your children and instruct them to comply with distancing guidelines, when in vans, and elsewhere.

- As an educational institution, we will be taking all reasonable measures, insha'allah, for the well-being and safety of our students, staff, and families, as we all struggle to sustain the teaching & learning process the best we can. The School is working hard toward achieving this goal.
