

Assessment Guidelines for Admission to Grade III

1) The child should be able to:

- Read books of the same level as Ladybird “Key Word Reading Scheme 12a, 12b, 12c” / Oxford Reading Tree stages 8 and 9 with comprehension.
- Understand and speak English.
- Write 6 to 7 sentences in correct English/Urdu on a given topic.
- Read, and do written comprehension of an unseen passage in English and Urdu.
- Tell place value in HTU. e.g. 345 = _____ hundreds, _____ tens, _____ units.
- Do simple addition, subtraction, multiplication & division sums and word problems.
- Calculate simple maths problems mentally as given in sample paper.

Assessment Guidelines for Admission to Grade IV

1) The child should be able to:

- Read extended stories of the same level as abridged Longman Classics up to level 2, with comprehension.
- Understand and speak English.
- Write 9 to 10 sentences (a paragraph) on a given topic, in English and Urdu.
- Read and do written comprehension of a given passage, in English and Urdu.
- Work out simple mathematical problems mentally. Do story sums involving the four operations (+, -, x, ÷), and write answer statements.
- Understand and work with concepts of fractions, length, time, area, graph, etc.

Assessment Guidelines for Admission to Grade V

1) The child should be able to:

- Read short stories and novels, of the same level as abridged Longman Classics level 3 with comprehension.
- Understand and speak English.
- Write a composition of about 100 words (2 paragraphs) on a given topic, in English and Urdu.
- Read and do written comprehension of a given passage in English and Urdu.
- Work out simple mathematical problems mentally.
- Solve mathematical problems involving four operations (+, -, \times , \div), and write answer statements.
- Understand and work with concepts of fractions, length, time, area, graph, etc.

Assessment Guidelines for Admission to Grade VI

1) The child should be able to:

- Read novels, short stories of the same level as abridged Longman classics up to level 4 with comprehension.
- Understand and speak English confidently and fluently.
- Write a composition with accuracy of language and varied sentence structure, of about 200 words, on a given topic in English and Urdu.
- Read, understand and answer questions based on a comprehension passage, in English and Urdu.
- Solve mathematical problems involving four operations (+, -, \times , \div) and write answer statement.
- Work with concepts of fractions, decimals, time and measurements (weight, volume, area, perimeter, etc).
