Innovation and Purpose!*

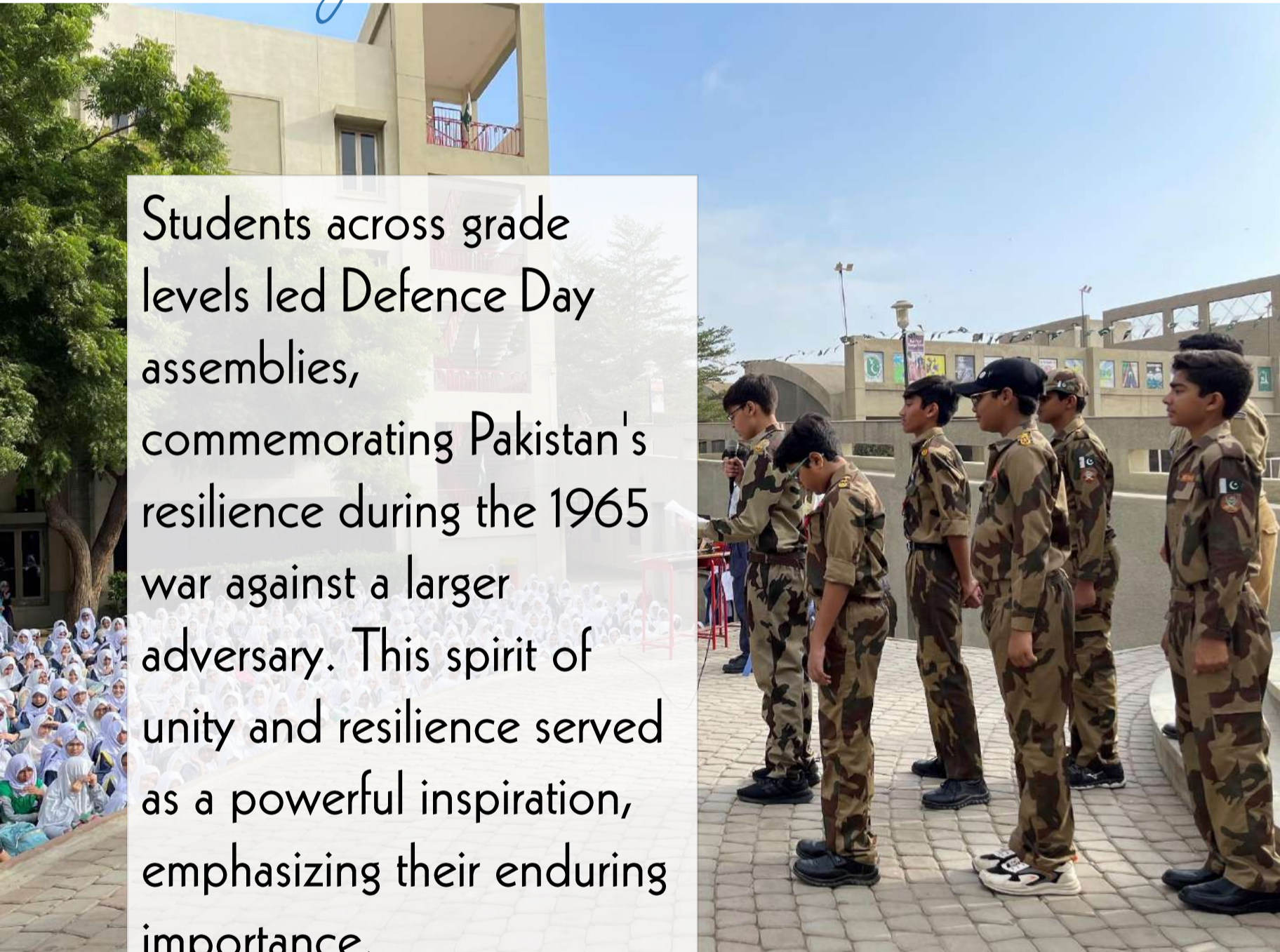

strong and united Pakistan!*

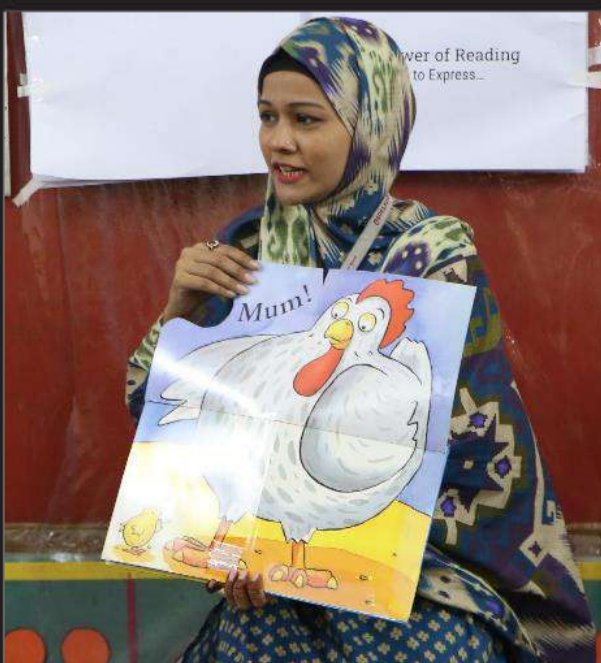
