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Introduction

Learning to Communicate

Children understand the world through their senses. Generians participate in a lot of storytelling sessions and pretend-play that help them develop vocabulary. They are encouraged to listen, draw and describe their experiences by asking & answering questions, speaking in clear and complete sentences. These activities help greatly in reading and writing success.



Focus on Cognitive Skills

Children are naturally curious to learn. They love to experiment and explore their world. With carefully designed activities, Generians are encouraged to ask questions, understand cause & effect and be able to give reasons.



Physical Well-being

A healthy mind needs a healthy body! Generians enjoy numerous outdoor activities that develop their observation, and bodily coordination. Activities like climbing, jumping, somersaulting, tracing patterns, settling in for snacks and cleaning-up afterwards are some of the many ways Generians become aware of controlling their bodies.
