

Assessment Guidelines for Admission to Grade IX

1) The child should be able to:

- Read** unabridged novels, short stories and plays with comprehension.
- Understand** and **speak** English / Urdu confidently.
- Read** and **comprehend** unseen passages.
Type of questions:
 - Literal
 - Inferential
 - Evaluative
 - Vocabulary
- Spell accurately the range of vocabulary used.
- Write** an essay/short story with accuracy of language, effective vocabulary and varied sentence structure, of about 250 words, in **(English and Urdu)**, on a given topic that can engage and sustain the interest of the reader.

- Basic geometrical concepts and properties

- Perimeter and area of simple geometrical figures

- Relationship b/w force, mass and acceleration (Newton Laws of motion)

$$P = F/A \quad [\text{Effect of force and area on Pressure}]$$
