FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is the Generation's College Programme?

The Generation's College Programme is a two-year study programme that culminates in the Advanced Level examinations conducted by Cambridge. As part of the programme, the Advanced Subsidiary (AS) examinations are typically taken at the end of the first year of study, and carry half the credit of the full A Level Examinations. Subsequently, the A2 examinations at the end of the second year account for the remaining credits.

Hence, for each subject of study, students will take the

- AS Level exams at the end of the first year of study; and
- A2 Level exams at the end of the second year of study.

The final A Levels grade will be a summative outcome of the AS and A2 exams. As an exception, General Paper is an AS Level examination.

Upon completion of the A Levels programme, students will insha'allah be eligible for universities and colleges - both locally and internationally.

2. What are the subjects offered at Generation's College for the A Levels session commencing August 2025?

The subjects offered at the A Levels are given in the table below. Students may select an appropriate subject combination, opting for 3, 4 or 5 subjects.

3. What is the fee structure for the Generation's College Programme?

Applicants are encouraged to submit their completed application as early as possible to ensure a favourable selection of subjects and the highest possible tiers of scholarship awards.

(Star Award – An extra 2% for every Cambridge A* (A-Star) Grade will be added to the applicable Basic Scholarship)

- Scholarship is applicable on the monthly tuition fee only.
- All scholarships will be reviewed at the end of the first year based on academic and social performance.
- Non-academic scholarships are available on an exceptional basis, based on sports and other co-curricular and social achievements.

5. What are the advantages of applying early?

Early applicants may gain an advantage in the following ways:

- The Early Admission Offer will secure you a place in the College Programme, thus giving you peace of mind.
- An early application will make you eligible for higher tiers of scholarship.
- The earlier you apply, the better the chances of you being able to study subjects of your choice.

6. What is the admission process for the Generation's College Programme?

- The application forms may be collected in person from the School's Front Office at the South Campus. Alternatively, they are available from the school website (www.generations.edu.pk).
- Timely submission will enable the College to not only offer early admission but also award you the highest level of scholarship that you may be eligible for.
- Upon submission of the forms, a discussion will be held with the applicant, parents and members of the faculty.

7. What factors will be considered for admissions and scholarships?

There will be a wide variety of factors considered - academic and non-academic - that may directly affect the college's decision to offer admission and scholarships. The college looks for students who have well-rounded personalities in all aspects, not just good grades. We seek students who have a competent repertoire of skills and interests, along with a strong sense of values and character. In particular, the school strongly considers the following.

- Social Conduct,
- Academic record, which shall necessarily include:
 - school transcripts, from grades VIII - XI
 - mock exam results,
 - final O Level grades,
- Cross-curricular activities and interests, such as sports and community service, and
- Principal's Recommendation Form
- Parents' and Student's discussions with the faculty will further inform the college of the aforementioned aspects.

8. What is an 'early admission offer'?

Upon fulfilling the criteria mentioned above, strong applicants may be offered 'early admission' which may be conditional or unconditional. Applicants who accept this offer can then be certain about their entry to the Generation's College Programme, as long as they meet the condition set for the final O Level grades.

To accept the early admission offer and confirm a place in the Generation's College Programme, applicants will be required to deposit an initial amount of Rs. 50,000/-, which will eventually be adjusted to work the fee payable for the session 2025-2027.

In case the applicant's final O Level grades do not meet the condition agreed upon earlier – and the school is, therefore, unable to offer admission – the deposit will be returned to the applicant in full.

9. What kind of leadership & engagement activities are planned for the College Programme?

To inculcate leadership skills within our student body, there is an extensive succession of leadership & engagement programmes in the form of clubs and societies at Generation's. Our students have been actively participating in – and winning great laurels locally and globally.

10. What will happen in August?

Applicants will be required to submit their O Level results within 48 hours of the announcement of the results by CIE. The final admission offers will be made based on the O Level results and the criteria.

The classes will commence in August 2024, insha'allah.
