



Assessment Guidelines for Admission to Grade VII

1) The child should be able to:

- Read** novels, short stories of the same level, as abridged Longman classics up to level 5.
- Understand** and **speak** English/Urdu confidently and fluently.
- Read** and **comprehend** unseen passages.
- Write an essay/short story with accuracy of language, effective vocabulary and varied sentence structure, of about 150 words (**English and Urdu**), on a given topic.

2) Work out:

- Story sums (**Arithmetical word problems**) and mental math around four operations (+, -, ×, ÷).
- Decimals and fractions.
- Real numbers (**addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of integers**).
- Basic concepts of Geometry (**point, line, Ray, Angles and construction**).
- Area and perimeter of simple figures.
- Percentages (**simple problems**).
- Factors and Multiples.

Note: It is important that the child comes for the test on time and carries complete stationery (Pen, pencil, erasers, etc.) as well as geometrical instruments (a pair of compasses, protractor).
