

Assessment Guidelines for Admission to Grade VII

The child should be able to:

English and Urdu

- Understand and speak confidently and fluently in English and Urdu
- Read with understanding, unabridged short stories and novels
- Write a descriptive or narrative essay / short story with accuracy of language, effective vocabulary, and varied sentence structure, of about 150 words on a given topic
- Read and answer comprehension questions based on a given passage

Mathematics

- Solve arithmetical word problems and carry out mental mathematics involving the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division)
- Work with real numbers, including the addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division of integers
- Understand the basic concepts of geometry, including point, line, ray, angles, and the construction of angles and shapes
- Calculate area and perimeter
- Work with percentages
- Identify factors and multiples
- Work with decimals and fractions

Important note: The child should come for the test on time and carry complete stationery (pen, pencil, eraser, etc.) as well as geometrical instruments (compass, protractor, ruler, etc).
